This year 169 students sat a most remarkable 450 A level papers, the largest ever entry! The most remarkable fact is the quality of the results; the pass rate (A* to E) was a fantastic 99%. This outstanding performance underlines Porthcawl as a truly inclusive school. Students have reached, and in most cases exceeded, their predicted potential.

There were many outstanding performers, with 20 students gaining 3 As or better at A level. Most notably, Jack Way who achieved a remarkable 3 A*s and 1 A grade and will now go on to Imperial College in London to study Physics. Four pupils gained 3 A* grades; namely Jack Bridger, Owen Leary, Tom Parry and Alicia Cooke, who has secured her place at Emmanuel College Cambridge to study Geography.

Students at AS and A2 have had their endeavour rewarded with excellent results. There is a large debt of gratitude for teachers who have worked so hard once again this year and for parents who have supported their sons and daughters. Excellent results truly reflect the effective partnership between a school, its learners and the support from home.

Headteacher Mr Slade commented that this excellent series of results will ensure Porthcawl students have secured places at some of the best universities in the country. Mr Slade continued to congratulate staff and students who were praised for their hard work and steadfast dedication. Mr Slade concluded that the results were especially impressive given the large size of the entry; over 450 papers were sat at A level.

Not to be out done, Year 12 delivered some of the best AS results Porthcawl has seen. With such a strong performance at AS we have high hopes for next year at A level. The A to E pass rate was 87%, up 2% on last year.

The following departments performed exceptionally, with pass rates above 85% (A* to E): English, Maths, History, Art, Religious Studies, Music, Drama, Electronics, Media Studies and Textiles.
