Porthcawl School is highly delighted to report a remarkable improvement in key areas of the school's performance. Hot on the heels of last week's outstanding A Level results the GCSE results really stand out!!

The % of pupils achieving 5 A* - C (Level 2) improved to a fantastic 89%. The pupils who gained 5 A* - C which includes English and Maths improved by almost 10% to a remarkable 74%.

Those who gained 5 A*/A grades improved to 35.8% which will compare most favourably locally and nationally.

The most exceptional performance was that of the English department where the A* - C (Level 2) outcome was an outstanding 88%.

A very pleasing trend was the outcomes for the boys, who have made significant improvements in all comparative indicators used. This is testament to the hard work of the pupils and staff.

We must mention the top performing pupils. This group of 53, achieved 8 or more GCSEs at A* / A.
