### A / And

The Welsh word for 'and' depends on what comes after it. The rule is:

- a before a consonant, e.g. afal a banana.
- ac before a vowel, e.g. banana ac afal.

### Y / The

The Welsh word for 'the' depends on what comes before and after it. The rule is:


- 'r after a vowel, e.g. Es i l'r sinema, Mae'r banc a'r ysgol yn y pentref.
- y before all consonants except h, e.g. y tîm, y bachgen.
- yr before all vowels & h, e.g. yr ellifant, yr haul, yr ysgol.




