Industrial Action – Thursday 2nd March

This week, I have been informed that the National Executive of the NEU (National Education Union) have rejected an offer put forward by Welsh Government. As a result, the NEU have confirmed that the previously postponed strike action will now take place on Thursday 2nd March.

At the time of writing, it is my understanding that negotiations continue, and therefore circumstances may change following the half term break. However, at this time, based on the information available to me it is likely that Porthcawl Comprehensive School will close to all pupils on Thursday 2nd March.
