Punctuality	<ul> <li>Arrive to school and all lessons on time.</li> <li>Line up outside of the classroom.</li> <li>Enter the classroom when your teacher tells you to do so.</li> </ul>
In lesson	<ul> <li>Sit in your allocated seat.</li> <li>Ensure you have the correct equipment. E.g. books, pens, pencils.</li> <li>Answer register clearly in Welsh.</li> <li>Work hard. Be respectful. Follow instructions first time. Never give up.</li> </ul>
Uniform	<ul> <li>Wear uniform as stated in our School Uniform Policy.</li> <li>Remove jackets / coats upon arrival to lessons.</li> <li>Only wear PCS hooded tops to PE lessons.</li> <li>Not wear Jewellery.</li> </ul>
Mobile Phones & Headphones	<ul> <li>Not be seen with a mobile phone – unless instructed by a member of staff.</li> <li>Expect to have phones confiscated if used without consent.</li> <li>Not use Headphones / EarPods.</li> <li>Expect these items to be confiscated.</li> </ul>
Movement around school	<ul> <li>Walk around the school site in an orderly manner.</li> <li>Only consume food and drink at break or lunchtime.</li> <li>Only drink water in lessons, but not in labs or ICT Suites.</li> <li>Have written consent from a member of staff to leave lessons.</li> </ul>
School Buildings	<ul> <li>Treat all school buildings, designated break and lunchtime areas and equipment with respect.</li> <li>Queue if required and asked.</li> <li>Put all rubbish in the correct bin and place plates and cutlery in designated areas of the canteen.</li> </ul>
