Restorative Detention

- 1 Ready Pupils are reminded about the expectations of everyone at PCS are you Ready to Learn?
- 2 Warn Staff will issue a verbal Warning if these expectations are not adhered to.
- **3 Move** If there is no improvement in behaviour the Pupil will be **Moved** to an alternative seat. A Negative will be issued on ClassCharts.
- **4 Remove** Failure to follow these instructions will result in pupil **Removal** to an alternative room or with the Duty Officer. A Negative will be issued on ClassCharts and a Restorative Detention with Class Teacher.

FAILURE TO ATTEND DEPARTMENTAL DETENTION WILL RESULT IN REFERRAL TO HEAD OF FACULTY/DEPARTMENT FOR FURTHER SANCTION.

Serious incidents will result in Duty Officer contact and removal from the classroom
