#### Year 10 GCSE Results - Thursday 22nd August 2024

- Students may pick up their results from reception between 8.30am and 10.00am on Thursday 22nd August 2024.
- Students requiring a review of marking will need to obtain a consent form and cost details from Mrs Henderson / Mrs Stephens in A Block office. The deadline for review of marking requests will be released by the exam boards closer to the time but is usually mid-September 2024. Again, anyone wishing to obtain a copy of their original script will need to apply in September. Confirmation of these dates will be sent when received from the exam boards.
- If the need arises, a decision on which modules to re-sit can be made when the results are analysed by your son's/daughter's teachers on return to school in September.

## Year 11 GCSE Results - Thursday 22nd August 2024

- Students may collect their results from the school Reception between 8.00am 9.30am on Thursday, 22nd August 2024.
- Ms Crook and Mrs Bennion, Sixth Form Tutors will be available throughout the morning of Results Day to discuss with all students any concerns or questions they may have about returning to Sixth Form. Please make the most of this opportunity to help you, and us, to plan for September.
- Please check carefully course requirements for the various AS subjects. Students' GCSE grades must match up with these to be accepted onto courses.
